


As the year comes to a close, we look back at the most popular career advice this year.

From the questions you legally can't be asked in an interview and how to craft a winning resume, to Australia's biggest earners and the most wanted skills, here are the Top Reads of 2018.




#1. Illegal interview questions, what employers have no right to ask

An interview is the perfect opportunity for a potential employer to assess your suitability for a role, but these seven questions are definitely out of bounds.




#2. Free cover letter template


#3. Free resume template

You should think of your resume as a billboard to advertise why you're great a for a position, instead of as an autobiography to document your entire career history. This template is designed to help you do just that.




#4. Cut these words from your resume immediately




